QUANTITY:	500 µg
SOURCE:	Human plasma cryoprecipitate (plasma fibronectin), assayed negative for hepatitis B virus, hepatitis C Virus (HCV), HIV-1, HIV-2, HTLV-1, HTLV-2 and <i>Treponema pallidum</i> . Handle as if potentially infectious.
PURITY:	One major band at 120kDa in SDS-PAGE; no higher molecular weight species present; smaller proteolytic fragments may be present. Purified by gel filtration chromatography.
PROPERTIES:	Contains the cell attachment region of fibronectin. F1904 is suitable for use in ELISA and affinity chromatography, and possibly molecular mapping of fibronectin function.
FORMAT:	Purified protein.
PRESENTATION:	Lyophilized in sodium citrate buffer, pH 7.4. Reconstitute with water.
STORAGE/HANDLING:	Maintain material at -20°C for 3 months or -70°C for six months.
