Sheep Serum is a pooled preparation obtained from a normal donor herd. Immunoelectrophoresis versus antish sheep serum results in multiple arcs of precipitation. The presence of endogenous antibodies has not been assayed.

Normal sheep serum is often used as a blocking agent or negative control in immunoassays.

This product is provided as a liquid containing as preservative.
